Every day we are given 86,400 seconds to use wisely. Every night God writes off as lost the time we have not used well or have wasted. In the bank of time, there are no balances and no overdrafts. Each day a new account is opened for us. Each night, what time we have failed to use is lost, is gone forever. Every second we are given has to be invested wisely, has to be invested in those things that will hold their value from day to day, from year to year. Such lasting values are things like justice, compassion, forgiveness, and love. In today's Gospel the five foolish bridesmaids squandered their time while wise ones made the best of every moment. 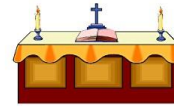

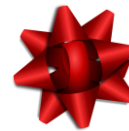
