


TODAY'S READINGS: *Lord, I am not worthy...*

Jesus teaches us that we should learn to place our confidence in God rather than in material things. What makes that so difficult for us is that it requires the ability to let go of things, and that requires the virtue of humility. Humility means being able to see, in complete honesty, where we stand before God. The truly humble person's need for God is strong because God's presence is fundamental to his or her happiness. For both the widows we meet in this week's readings, God's presence in their lives was more important than any particular thing they may have owned. These women are wonderful examples of the ideal believer who trusts completely in God. Like these two widows we want to give Him our all. We want to put all our faith and trust in Him. To do this we need to be assured that He sees us, that He knows us, that He cares for us at all times, and in all the situations of life in which we find ourselves. As with all skills in life, if we want to excel at them we must use them. Being humble, before the Lord, begins in acknowledging that we are sinners and at the same time knowing we are loved, forgiven and healed by our God. Let's make a new start!

...but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

OUR 'LIVE SIMPLY' TIPS FOR THIS WEEK:

Saving Water: Exasperated by the amount of water wasted in the shower whilst waiting for the water to turn hot? Keep a bucket in the shower to collect the otherwise waste water and use it for flushing the loo

Use vinegar

- Remove stickiness on wood with cotton cloth dampened with vinegar.
- To clean shower heads with a damp tooth brush or nailbrush
- With crunched up newspaper for cleaning windows
- With baking soda for drains
