**TODAY'S READINGS:**

*From Water to Wine to Blood...*

Three mysteries mark the Epiphany. We have already celebrated two of them: the Magi's visit and Jesus' Baptism. Today we celebrate the third - the miracle at Cana. When told there was no wine Jesus says, *what's that got to do with me – My Hour has not yet come!* But Jesus does provide wine and in a miraculous way. In so doing He opens up the way that ultimately leads to His passion, death and resurrection – since that is 'His Hour.' And yet in a way 'His Hour' begins with this epiphany, when water is changed into wine. Soon He will transform wine into His blood. The water, Jesus changed into wine at Cana, was set aside for purification rites; this change foreshadows the wine that will become the new purification rite - the Eucharistic Blood of the Lord. The miracle of Cana completes the Epiphany. The Saviour of the World has come. Just as He transformed water into wine, and wine into blood, so now He is transforming our world into the Kingdom of God. We have been given the grace to be members of that Kingdom and with that grace comes the responsibility of sharing the Good News of the Gospel with the world of today.
