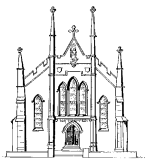

**READINGS FOR PENTECOST**

*They were all filled with the Holy Spirit...*

Once the Apostles heard the Holy Spirit speaking in their hearts they wanted to share their faith to others and off they went! They took, and preached, the Gospel message to places as far away from Jerusalem as Spain, Ethiopia and India. They had no great education, no money or position in society, but what they did have was a deep, infectious, and living faith in Jesus. Today's feast invites us to do the same thing; to listen to the Holy Spirit and to share our faith, with joy, to others. It is our words and our lives that proclaim Jesus. When what we say and what we do flow from our faith in Jesus, we influence and bring others to want to listen to the Holy Spirit (see Acts of the Apostles!). St Francis of Assisi summed this up when he said: *"Preach the Gospel at all times, and if necessary, use words."* Let our lives communicate the Gospel to those we meet this coming week. Everyone understands good example. We have been empowered to bring peace to a world that longs to be rescued from chaos. May we have the courage to talk with our lives to others so that the Holy Spirit can speak to their hearts.
