

Sunday - Easter Week 5

St Dunstan (*909 Baltonsborough – 19th May 988 Canterbury*)
Pastor
Patron saint of blacksmiths

Collect:

and, though pitiable, made blessed,
stand, we pray, by Your works,
stand by Your gifts,
that those justified by faith
may not lack the courage of perseverance.
Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son,
who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Oh God of truth and beauty,
You not only blessed Bishop Dunstan

St Christopher of Magallanes (30th July 1869 Totatiche, Mexico - 25th May 1927, Colotlán, Mexico) and his 21 companion martyrs

that those You render capable of immortality
by justifying them
may by Your guidance
attain the fullness of glory.

Today's Gospel reading: John 15:18-21

Today's prayer:

Almighty and eternal God,
who made the Priest Saint Christopher Magallanes
and his 21 companions
faithful to Christ the King even to the point of martyrdom,
grant us, through their intercession,
that, persevering in confession of the true faith,
we may always hold fast to the commandments of Your love.
Through Christ, our Lord. Amen.

Saint Christopher, Pray for us

All holy martyrs, pray for us

Saint Christopher worked in the fields until he was 19. He was ordained in September 1899 and was appointed chaplain and vice principal of a school of arts and trades in Guadalajara. He organized catechism centers and schools for those of living in the countryside. He built a dam to help in irrigation, founded homes for orphans and small plots of land to help the poor. He worked in the Parish of Totalice for 17 years before he was shot on May 21st 1927 on the way to celebrate Mass. Before he was shot, he said, "I am innocent, and I die innocent; I forgive the authors of my death from my heart and I ask God that my blood would serve to bring peace to divided Mexicans." Beatified on November 22nd 1992 and canonized by Pope St John Paul II on May 21st 2000.
