## **TODAY'S READINGS**

*...the offering of Your high priest Melchizedek...*

Melchizedek is an extraordinary character; he was both a priest and the king of Salem. He was chosen by God to offer a sacrifice of bread and wine in thanksgiving for God's faithful people. For us Melchizedek foreshadows Jesus. Jesus is the Eternal Priest and the King of Kings who offers both a sacrifice of thanksgiving for His people in the form of bread and wine and offers His very self on the Cross. Jesus is both the sacrifice and the offering. (This is the 'oblation' that the new translation of the Mass so often mentions.) The incident with Melchizedek helps us understand more clearly the wonder of the Eucharist. Melchizedek offered a gift of thanksgiving to God; Jesus' gift of the Eucharist means thanksgiving. In receiving communion we join with Jesus in giving thanks to God for all He does for us. The gift of the Body and Blood of Christ is the greatest gift possible. It is His sacrifice on the Cross made real in the Eucharist given to us to eat and given to nourish us. Psalm 110 foretells of the Messiah who would be a priest of the order of Melchizedek – this is Jesus, Priest and King. His gift to us, the Eucharist, is always to be celebrated and treasured by each of us, for we too are the descendants of Abraham, and we too are God's faithful people.

**Eucharistic Ministers at Corpus Christi:** This Sunday is the Feast of Corpus Christi when we celebrate the Eucharist. At the weekend masses after Communion I will be inviting the Eucharistic Ministers to come forward to renew their ministry.

**WORLD REFUGEE DAY** is Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June. This is an international day designated by the United Nations to honour refugees around the globe. It celebrates the strength and courage of people who have been forced to flee their home country to escape conflict or persecution. World Refugee Day is an occasion to build empathy and understanding for their plight and to recognize their resilience in rebuilding their lives. This year, the focus will be on the right to seek safety. Every person on this planet has a right to seek safety – whoever they are, wherever they come from and whenever they are forced to flee.

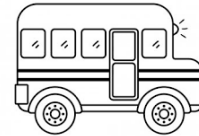
