TODAYS' READINGS

Mary is assumed into Heaven...

While the Scriptures do not explicitly refer to Our Lady's Assumption, it is implicit everywhere in the promise that God will *exalts* and give glory to all, who like Mary, trust in His goodness and obey His commandments. The *proud of heart* and the *mighty* presume that power alone will serve their purposes; consequently, they can look down on those who accept Jesus' teaching that we should be a loving, caring presence in the world. They see it as foolish and unpromising. Our Lady's Assumption celebrates the victory of love over hatred, of mercy over cruelty, and of gentleness over violence. In a society where power is seen as a way of getting things done, it is too easy to be tempted to abandon the wisdom of Jesus. This is why today's feast is so important. It provides us with an opportunity to reaffirm our faith in God's promises. God really does remember His promises made to Abraham and therefore to all who are his *descendants*, his spiritual children. God will *exalt the lowly* and *fill the hungry with good things*. Let us join with Mary and proclaims the greatness of the Lord; for all that He has done for us, let us, each day, proclaim in what we say and do the One who is our Lord and Saviour.
