TODAYS' READINGS

Faith is the assurance of things hoped for...

Abraham, 'our father in faith' as the First Eucharist describe him, is seen as *our father in faith* because of all the figures of Hebrew Scriptures he gives the greatest example of what faith truly is. He was promised that his *descendants would be as numerous as the sands of the seashore or stars of the sky*. He had faith that God would be true to His promise, even when He demanded the most extraordinary test of Abraham's faith: the sacrifice Isaac, his son. With faith, he prepared to do as God asked him. Faith means stepping into the unknown and trusting in God. It asks for a way of thinking that is completely opposite to the expectations of people of today. Faith says that we cannot find the answers ourselves, we have to trust in God and He will find ways for us to confront and conquer life's challenges. It is easy to take the way of least resistance in every aspect of our lives but not a rewarding way to go. We can easily reject having the deep faith that Abraham demonstrates, but in doing so we deny who we really are; the chosen People of God. Today we pray for a deepening of our faith and of our commitment to living the way of the Gospel despite what it many cost us!
