

St Chad and St Cedd belonged to a family of brothers, and all six of them were chosen by King Oswald of Northumbria to be trained by St Aidan to be monks and missionaries. This was in 635, when Aidan came from the monastery of Iona in Scotland to become bishop of King Oswald's kingdom.

Friday – Saints Simon and Jude

Apostles

St. Simon is the patron saint of leather tanners.

St. Jude is the patron of hopeless causes because of the miraculous cure of the King of Edessa who had leprosy.

Collect:

O God, who by the blessed Apostles
have brought us to acknowledge Your Name,
graciously grant,
through the intercession of Saints Simon and Jude,
that the Church may constantly grow
by increase of the peoples who believe in You.
Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son,
who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Today's Gospel reading: Luke 6:12-19

Today's Prayer:

Saints Simon and Jude,
I ask for your intercession
I ask you, on my behalf, to approach the Lord Jesus
with my needs in your hands.
Answer the prayers I bring
and fulfil the petitions I present to you.

Sts Simon and Jude, Pray that I will faithfully live Jesus' teachings and share it with others.

St Simon is often referred to as Simon the Zealot, which clearly distinguishes him from Simon Peter. Both are regularly mentioned in the New Testament. The most commonly accepted tradition is that, after Jesus' ascension, Sts Simon and Jude travelled and preached the Gospel separately, before jointly evangelising in the Mediterranean and the Middle East. St's Simon and Jude were martyred around 65AD in Beirut. Their remains were later transferred to St Peter's Basilica in Rome.
