TODAY'S READINGS: I once was lost...

This Sunday is 'Gaudete' Sunday, 'Rejoice' Sunday'. St Paul says in the second reading, "*Be happy at all times: pray constantly and for all things give thanks to God.*" 'Rejoice', this Sunday tells us! This is a time of great expectations.
