TODAY'S READINGS: The King of kings salvation brings;

The Epiphany celebrates the coming of the Wise Men to the child Jesus. It's the celebration at the end of a long and arduous journey which concludes with the revelation of Truth. When they arrive, they find an ordinary family. The stable is blessed by their arrival and their gifts: the splendour of gold for a king, the luxury of frankincense for the worship of God and the tenderness of myrrh for burial. Their gifts express both the hopes and anxieties of the future. That humble stable is blessed not by those visitors, but by the One they visit. The blessing is received not by the Host, but by the guests. The real gifts are received not by the family, but by those who give them. The Truth is revealed to those who carry it. The visit of the Wise Men is a model of all our worship of God, and indeed the model of what it means to have faith. We praise and bless Him, yet we are the ones who receive His blessing. We bring Him gifts - but we receive the gift of His grace. The Host receives us into His presence, but we receive the Host.
