**TODAY'S READINGS:**

To You, before Your passion, they sang their hymns of praise...

Attending Mass, especially at Christmas and Easter, often leaves us uplifted. Confession and Holy Communion bring a deep awareness of God's love within us. These moments place us among the crowd joyfully welcoming the Messiah into our hearts. But after the joy comes the challenge: the sacrificial path to Calvary—a road that can feel difficult and overwhelming. Yet we are invited to walk it with Him. The world mocks us: *Look at what you're missing!* But following Christ, though hard, leads us to Calvary—where we turn and say to the world: *No—look at what you're missing!* The Cross stands as the ultimate witness to God's love. We follow Jesus not only in the triumph of waving palms, but in the true triumph of His Cross. Palm Sunday marks both His joyful entrance into Jerusalem and His sorrowful path to Calvary—one event, one call to follow Him through joy and suffering alike. May this Holy Week draw us deeper into the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. All glory, laud, and honour to You, Redeemer King!
