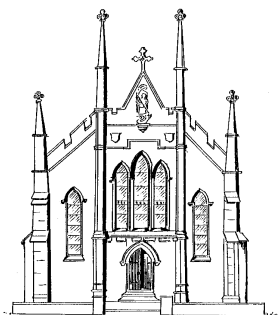

St John, Pray for us

St John of Ávila (6th January 1499– 10th May 1569) he was a Spanish priest, preacher, scholastic author, and religious mystic, who has been declared a saint and Doctor of the Church. He was the spiritual director of Saint Teresa of Avila. He is called the "Apostle of Andalusia", for his extensive ministry in that region.
