TODAY'S READINGS:

They were all filled with the Holy Spirit...

Once the Apostles heard the Holy Spirit speaking in their hearts, they couldn't keep it to themselves—they set out to share the Good News! They carried the Gospel far from Jerusalem, reaching as far as Spain, Ethiopia, and India. They weren't highly educated, wealthy, or influential, but what they did have was a deep, living, and contagious faith in Jesus. Today's feast invites us to do the same: to listen to the Holy Spirit and share our faith with joy. It's not just our words, but our lives that proclaim Christ. When our actions and our speech flow from our faith, we become instruments through which others may begin to hear the Spirit too—just read the Acts of the Apostles! St Francis of Assisi put it simply: "Preach the Gospel at all times; if necessary, use words." Let our lives speak the Gospel in the days ahead. Everyone understands the power of a good example. We have been empowered to bring peace into a world longing for rescue from chaos. May we have the courage to speak with our lives, so that the Holy Spirit may speak to others through us.
