**TODAY'S READINGS: *Doing matters....***

In Luke 10:38–42, we find Jesus welcomed into the home of two sisters, Martha and Mary. Martha's rushing around, trying to get everything just right: setting the table, preparing food, being the perfect host. Meanwhile, Mary is simply sitting at Jesus' feet, soaking in every word he says. Eventually, Martha has had enough and asks Jesus to step in. "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do all the work? Tell her to help me!" But Jesus doesn't take the side she's expecting. Instead, he gently says, "Martha, Martha, you're worried and distracted by so many things—but only one thing really matters. Mary has chosen it." It's a scene many of us can relate to. We get caught up in the doing—trying to be productive, helpful, responsible—and sometimes forget to simply be with Jesus. This isn't a story about one sister being better than the other. It's about timing, focus, and what fuels our actions. Jesus isn't scolding Martha for serving; he's reminding her (and us) that being close to him is the starting point. There will always be things to do—but if we don't pause to listen, we might miss the most important thing of all.
