**HOLY TRINITY & ST GEORGE****CATHOLIC CHURCH****THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS****14th SEPTEMBER 2025****TODAY'S READINGS: *The Holy Cross...***

The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross is always kept on 14th September. It recalls both the discovery of the True Cross in Jerusalem by St Helena in the fourth century and the dedication of the basilica built to honour it. Yet the feast is more than a memory of events long past. It is the Church's way of proclaiming that the Cross, once an instrument of shame, is now the tree of life, the throne of mercy, and the sign of victory. We exalt the Cross because in it Christ has reconciled the world to the Father. It is the place where sin is defeated, death is conquered, and love is revealed in its fullest depth. To venerate the Cross is to recognise in it the source of our salvation and the pattern of our discipleship: to take up our own cross each day and follow Him. For that reason the Cross must never be misused—as a decoration, a superstition, or a weapon. It is holy because it is His. We lift it high in reverence, never in pride.


