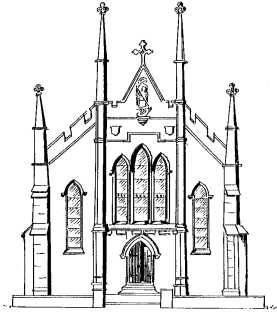

# Sunday – Week 26

O Good Shepherd seek me out and bring me home in accord with Your

and praise You for ever and ever  
with those who are there. Amen.

*Saint Jerome, (342 Stridon - 420 Bethlehem) was one of the four original Western doctors of the Church. He is perhaps best known for translating the Bible from Greek into Latin). A remarkable scholar and a sometimes-prickly man, Saint Jerome nevertheless believed deeply in the mercy of Christ, as this prayer above shows.*

# Wednesday - Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus

Virgin and Doctor of the Church

*patron saint of missions and of florists*

we may see Your eternal glory revealed.

God, for ever and ever. Amen.

**Today's Gospel reading:** Matthew 18:1-4

God who opens Your Kingdom to the small and humble,  
help me to walk in confidence  
in the footsteps of Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus  
to thereby obtain the revelation of Your glory.  
Through Jesus Christ, Your Son,

*she taught that holiness is found in daily fidelity.*

**Today's Prayer:** St Francis of Assisi's vocation prayer

Most High, Glorious God,  
enlighten the darkness of our minds.  
Give us a right faith,  
a firm hope and a perfect charity,  
so that we may always  
and in all things act according to Your Holy Will. Amen.

St Francis, Pray for us

*Saint Francis of Assisi (1181/82–1226) is one of the Church's most beloved saints. Born Giovanni di Pietro di Bernardone in Assisi, Italy, he renounced wealth to live in poverty, embracing Christ in simplicity and joy. He founded the Order of Friars Minor (Franciscans), inspiring renewal through preaching, service, and love for creation. Known for receiving the stigmata in 1224, Francis bore the marks of Christ's Passion. He composed the "Canticle of the Creatures," praising God through all creation. He died on October 3, 1226, and was canonized in 1228.*
