Why did only one leper come back to give thanks to God? And what happened to the other nine? Maybe some were angry — angry that they'd been so ill for so long, unable to see their healing as a gift. For them, sickness had felt like a curse. Perhaps others were simply disappointed, thinking of all they'd missed in life, seeing the glass half empty. And maybe a few were just caught up in themselves — like children who've never learned to say "thank you," assuming they deserve every good thing that comes their way. It's sobering, isn't it?
