TODAY'S READINGS:

We have been trusted to look after something precious ...

God has entrusted each of us with gifts: some personal, others shared by all His people. Among these shared gifts, three in particular make us a living Church. The first is baptism. In those waters we were made God's children, freed from sin, and joined to Christ's Body. Baptism is the gateway to grace, the beginning of a life lived with God. The second is the Word of God. Scripture is not just a guidebook or words of comfort; it is God Himself speaking, revealing His truth, His will, and His love, inviting us to let His story shape our lives. The third is the Eucharist. Here, bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ. This is not only a sacred act of devotion but the very food that sustains our spiritual life—the source and summit of our faith. Through these gifts—Baptism, the Word, and the Eucharist—Christ strengthens us and sends us out to proclaim His Kingdom. Today we pray for the grace to treasure these gifts and to share them boldly with the world.
