TODAY'S READINGS: Stay awake...

Advent begins with two wonderfully hopeful readings — and a warning! Jeremiah speaks to a people crushed by disaster: the Babylonians have torn them from their homeland and dragged them into exile. The Hebrews know they have sinned; was this exile their own doing? Had God finally abandoned them? Jeremiah answers with a clear and tender no: God has not given up on His people. A day will come when a righteous shoot from David's line will lead them, and Jerusalem will be safe once more. St Paul writes to the Thessalonians — unsettled by the thought that the Lord's return was close — and tells them simply to abound in love for one another, so that they may stand blameless before God when Christ comes again. These are deeply consoling words, especially beside Jesus' warning in the Gospel: strange signs in the heavens, fear, and even death. Yet He adds that when the Son of Man comes on the clouds with power and great glory, we should lift up our heads, for our redemption draws near. Waiting for the Lord's coming is the heart of this first week of Advent. And this waiting isn't passive. It's the quiet, steady readiness that uses well the time and gifts we have been given — preparing our hearts for the One who is surely coming.

...for the Lord is at hand!
