The Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica reminds us that the Church is not simply a building, but a living people, gathered and transformed by Christ. The Lateran Basilica is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome, the Pope, and therefore the mother and head of all churches in the world. When we honour its dedication, we are honouring the unity of the whole Church and our deep belonging within it. This feast invites us to reflect on what it means to be the "Temple of God" (1 Corinthians 3:16). God no longer dwells in stone buildings alone, but in the hearts of those who have been baptised into Christ. Yet our church buildings still matter: they are places where Heaven touches Earth, where the Sacrifice of the Mass is offered, where we encounter mercy and communion, where we kneel together before the Lord. In a world that can feel fragmented and individualistic, this feast calls us back to our shared identity. We are not isolated believers, but living stones built together on Christ the Cornerstone. To celebrate this day is to renew our commitment to unity, holiness, and mission—becoming, together, a dwelling place fit for the presence of God.
