Our Lady's Christmas Day Message given to Marija Pavlovic-Lunetti: "Dear children! TODAY'S READINGS:

Carpe Diem ...

Jesus saw John standing in the Jordan, calling people into the water — ordinary, sincere people ready to begin again. And then Jesus did something astonishing: He stepped into the river with them. As He rose from the water, Heaven opened and the Father's voice was heard: "This is my Beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." The ordinary became holy. The river became a place where God speaks. Each of us is given moments when God invites us to change — moments of grace that pass close enough to

touch. Some are obvious: the great milestones of faith in our lives and families. Others are quieter, easily missed — ordinary days when God whispers, "Come into the water." To seize the day is not about haste, but about courage: the courage to respond, to step forward, to make the ordinary extraordinary. Christ already stands in the river. He waits for us there. May Jesus, baptised by John in the Jordan, give us the courage to join Him — and to hear spoken over our own lives the words of the Father's love.

... . Seize the moment. Seize the day!
