TODAY'S READINGS: *I have called you by your name...*

We are all called to bring God's light into the world. This calling is not optional, nor is it reserved for a few. It belongs to every baptised person. Faith is not simply a private belief we hold in our minds, nor only a set of moral values we try to live by. Faith is about identity. It is about who we are and why we exist. Through baptism, we were given more than a name or a place in the Church. We were made children of God. The Creator of the universe — the One who sustains every star, every distant galaxy, and every hidden corner of creation — knows each of us personally and calls us His own. In baptism, God did not merely give us life; He shared His own divine life with us. We became members of His family, joined to Christ, and made temples of the Holy Spirit. Confirmation builds upon that gift. It is not a graduation from faith, but a commissioning into mission. In confirmation, the Holy Spirit strengthens us so that we may live and witness to our faith openly and courageously. The Lord entrusts us with responsibility, saying in effect: These are my people. They are my witnesses in the world. Through the Spirit, we are equipped to speak the truth in love, to stand firm in hope, and to draw others toward Christ by the way we live. The Church does not exist for herself. We exist so that the world might come to know salvation in Jesus Christ. Each of us has a role to play in that mission, not through perfection, but through faithfulness. We are the people of God. May we have the courage to live as the people God has created and called us to be.
